Victory

With a new calendar year comes the beginning of a new high school sport season. Soccer teams across the state of Texas have been practicing for weeks, but official games did not begin until the new year.

The Castleberry High School Lady Lions soccer team opened their 2023 season with a home game against the Lady Eagles of Oak Cliff Faith Academy on Tuesday, Jan. 3.

The Lady Lions led 2-0 at halftime. Eventually they stretched their lead to 4-0 before the Lady Eagles scored a couple of meaningless goals in the last 14 minutes to make the final score of 4-2 look closer than it was in reality.

The first 20 minutes of the first half was thoroughly dominated by the Lady Lions. The Eagles goalie was very good and was kept very busy while keeping CHS scoreless. Were it not for her outstanding defense this game could have been a blowout for the Lady Lions.

Despite 10 shots on goal in the first 20 minutes CHS could not score. At the 20:36 mark CHS freshman Alexa Rivera (#10) got a terrific shot on goal but the Lady Eagle goalie made a great save. Up until this point the Lady Eagles had not even advanced the ball offensively well enough to manage a single shot on goal. At the 5:41 mark Rivera got another great shot on goal that was again excellently defended by the goalie.

But the Lady Eagles could not continue to rely on their goalie to save every kick the entire night. At the 4:45 mark junior Lesly Martinez Vegan (#20) finally got a kick past the Lady Eagle goalie and put CHS on the scoreboard. About one minute later, at the 3:35 mark, CHS scored again. Rivera was rewarded for her relentless play when she launched a rocket from over 20 yards out that hit paydirt. The Lady Lions went up (continued on page 3)


