Benbrook Council Seeks Applicants for Boards & Commissions

Fort Worth to Host Warrant Forgiveness Event Saturday



The Benbrook City Council is now accepting applications from residents interested in serving on one of the city's boards or commissions.

Openings are available on the Planning and Zoning Commission, the Zoning Board of Adjustment/Appeals Commission, the Parks and Recreation Board, and the Benbrook Economic Development Corporation Board of Directors.

The City of Fort Worth and District 11 are inviting residents with outstanding municipal court citations to participate in a "Court in the Community Warrant Forgiveness" event set for Saturday, Oct. 18, from 9 a.m. to noon at New Riverside United Methodist Church, located at 3419 E. Belknap Street.

The event is designed to offer a "safe harbor court" setting, allowing people with Class C criminal cases through Fort Worth Municipal Court to engage with city staff and explore options to resolve their cases without fear of arrest.

Attendance is limited: only the first 120 people will be served, and all cases will be handled on a first-come, first-served basis.

Beyond court assistance, the event will offer walk-up services free of charge, including:

- Support from the City of Fort Worth EnVision Center and Community Action Partner for rental, utility, tuition, and job-search resources.
- Job placement, counseling, and career-readiness support from Goodwill North Central Texas, including help with resumes and interview preparation.

As Fort Worth continues addressing access to justice and community support, the "Court in the Community" event represents one of the city's steps toward making court obligations more manageable for its residents.
