Benbrook Council Action

July 2 Meeting Review by John English

The Benbrook City Council meeting was held on Tuesday, July 2 as last Thursday was Independence Day. Mayor Jason Ward called the meeting to order. An invocation was followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Time was then allowed for citizen comments on any agenda item, but there were none. The minutes from the previous meeting held on June 20 were then approved unanimously.

The first item of the evening was a proposal to authorize an interlocal agreement with the Benbrook Water Authority (BWA) for residential refuse and stormwater utility fee and payment collection. According to the agenda, the proposed agreement establishes a reimbursement to the BWA of 49.58 cents per bill, which is identical to last year's rate. In addition, the City is assessed its proportionate share of the credit card processing fee for residents paying with credit cards. The BWA processes credit card payments through a merchant services provider. The provider charges a percentage (normally between 1.5% and 3%) on each transaction based on the type of card and transaction. The term of the proposed interlocal agreement is one year, beginning Oct. 1, 2024, and ending Sept. 30, 2025. The agreement was unanimously approved.

Next was a motion to authorize an interlocal agreement with the BWA for street repair services. The proposed agreement renews Benbrook's longstanding agreement with the BWA allowing the City of Benbrook to complete street cuts for the BWA. The repair cost (continued on page 4)



Plan for the Texas Sales Tax Holiday Aug. 9-11

The Comptroller encourages all taxpayers to support Texas businesses while saving money on tax-free purchases of most clothing, footwear, school supplies and backpacks (sold for less than \$100) during the annual Tax-Free weekend.

Qualifying items can be purchased tax free from a Texas store or from an online or catalog seller doing business in Texas. In most cases, you do not need to give the seller an exemption certificate to buy qualifying items tax free.

This year's sales tax holiday begins Friday, Aug. 9, and goes through midnight Sunday, Aug. 11.

The sales tax exemption applies only to qualifying items you buy during the sales tax holiday. Items you buy before or after footwear and other qualifying items. the sales tax holiday do not qualify for exemption, and there is no tax refund available.

Additional Charges Affect the Sales Price

Delivery, shipping, handling and transportation charges by the seller are part of the item's sales price.

Since clothing, backpacks and school supplies have to be less than \$100 to qualify, you have to look at the item's total sales price to determine if you can buy it tax free.

For example, you buy a pair of jeans for \$95 with a \$10 delivery charge for a total price of \$105. Because the jeans' total price is more than \$100, tax is due on the entire \$105 price.

If a delivery charge is billed per item, and an invoice has both exempt and taxable items, only the qualifying exempt item's delivery charge is exempt.



If the delivery charge is a flat rate per package, and the amount charged is the same regardless of how many items are included in the package, the total charge can be attributed to any one of the items in the package.

Sales Tax Holiday Refund Requests

If you pay sales tax on qualifying items during the sales tax holiday, you can ask the seller for a refund of the tax paid. The seller can either grant the refund or provide their customer with Form 00-985, Assignment to Right to Refund (PDF), which allows the purchaser to file the refund claim directly with the Comptroller's office.

STANDARD RESTRAINING ORDER

The First French King to Claim Texas - Louis XIV



Texas has been a land under control of many different flags in its long history. From the early Native American tribes to the European colonial powers to the United States, each era has left an impact on the state. One of those figures to claim Texas was Louis XIV, king of France. He was the first French king to claim Texas, an important moment in Texas History, and would greatly influence all of Europe.

The future Louis XIV was born in 1638 at the royal palace of his father, King Louis XIII, and his mother, Queen Anne. Born into ostentatious luxury and unlimited power, he wanted for nothing. In 1643, his father died after a prolonged illness. As the oldest surviving male heir, he became king while only four years old.

Since he was so young, a regency was declared by his father's ministers. At such a young age, he could not begin to understand even the most basic functions of the government. Cardinal Jules Mazarin, who had been chief minister to Louis XIII and a senior official in the Roman Catholic Church, would retain his position and make decisions in the young king's name. In spite of his church position, Mazarin was a veteran European politician and diplomat, known for his skills and his cunning far more than his faith. Louis XIV's widowed mother doted on him.
